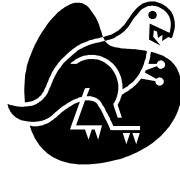




## MAPLE CLASS ASSEMBLY

Children who currently receive instrumental tuition in school have received letters regarding continuing their lessons next Autumn term - please return your slips promptly.

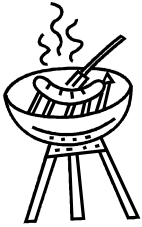
If you would like your child to start instrumental tuition from September please send a note to the school office, stating which instrument you would like your child to be assessed on, as soon as possible. (Lessons will be arranged in the next three weeks so please do not delay your request.) Tuition is for children in Years 2-6 only and if spaces are short preference will be given to older children.

Instruments taught (subject to availability) are:

**Brass ~ Cello ~ Drums ~ Guitar ~ Piano ~ Violin ~ Woodwind**

You will be required to provide your child with a suitable instrument. *Please note that some stringed instruments may be available for loan in the first instance, when children begin lessons.*

Lessons in the Autumn term will cost £110.50 which must be paid in advance by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July. *Families in receipt of Income Support/Widow's Pension are eligible to claim a refund of £25 ~ please ask the school office for a claim form.*
