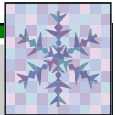


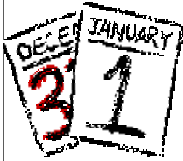

I hope that you all have a happy and healthy 2010.



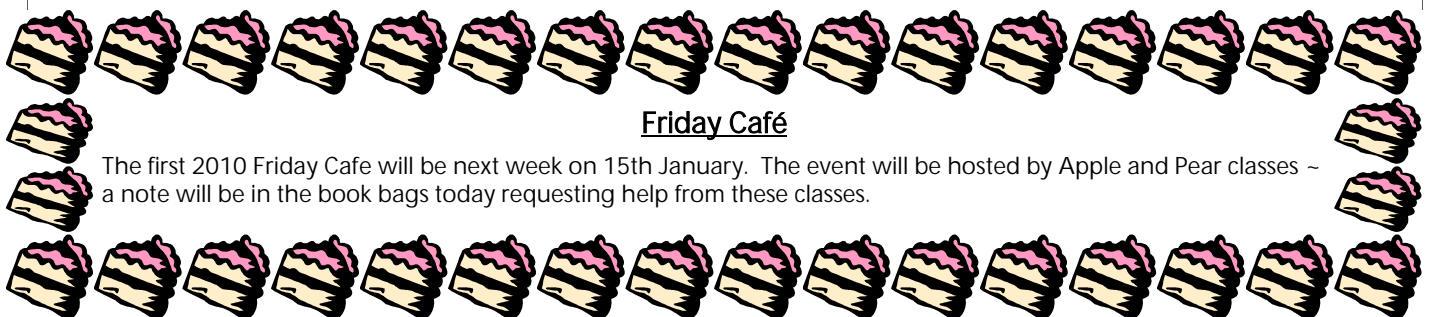
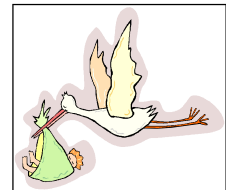
Cold Weather
